

Foundations of Community Greeters

Every Sunday we need two greeters. Greeters provide a warm welcome at each of the entrances when members and visitors arrive on Sunday morning.

As a Sunday morning greeter, you will:

- Receive a brief training to let you know about common questions visitors might ask.
- Arrive by 10:00 am to find your nametag, help set up the greeters table.
- Offer a friendly smile and greeting to those entering by the Church Street or Massachusetts Avenue entrances. If only one greeter is available the Mass. Ave. entrance is a priority for before service. The Church St. entrance is a priority after the service.
- Help visitors fill out a nametag and find their way to the sanctuary, Helverson Parlor, bathrooms, nursery, or Religious Education classrooms.
- Greeters have no responsibilities during the worship service.
- The Mass. Ave. greeter leaves the service during the postlude and stands near the Mass. Ave. door to say goodbye and thank people for attending the service. They can also answer visitors questions. Once the traffic stops, go to social hour and talk with visitors.
- The Church St. greeter stands by the greeter table after the service and answers questions and greets newcomers. Remain until most people have left social hour (until about 12:30 pm)
- Please leave all collected visitor/nametag cards in our Office Coordinator's mailbox in the Church office.
